

Enclose Cass Extravaganza Broomball Event

November 5, 2016

We will be accepting a maximum of 16 teams into the Broomball games. Teams should consist of a minimum of 6 and a maximum of 10 players.

The cost is as follows (each team will play one game):

Register as a:

- Team 6-10 players - \$100/team
- Family \$30/family (minimum age is 8).
- Individual - \$10/person.

****Individuals will be placed with families or other individuals to make teams of 10. All participants will sign a liability waiver (adults needed to sign for players under 18).***

Game Basics:

Game: Games will be played cross-ice and consist of two 12 minute running time periods. Once play is underway the clock will run until the end of the period. We anticipate up to three games being played at the same time cross-ice.

Equipment:

BROOM – Brooms, balls and nets will be provided.

FOOTWEAR – clean sneakers or winter boots

HELMETS are required (bike, hockey, ski, etc).

PROTECTIVE PADS- other protective pads (elbow pads, gloves, etc) are encouraged but optional.

TEAM COLORS – Teams should identify a color they would like to wear. Pinnies will be available, if necessary.

Teams: Each team will only be allowed 4 players and a goalie on the ice at a time. Teams can consist of up to ten members with changing “on the fly”.

Rules:

- Games will be non-officiated and should be played in a friendly and safe manner. [There will be volunteers on site to settle any disputes.]
- Each period will begin with a face-off at center ice. These should be the only face-off's of the game. After a goal is scored the defensive side gets

the ball with the opposing team giving them 6 feet.

- Off Sides and Icing: Players must be on their respective sides of center ice for each period's initial face-off. After that there will be no off sides or icing rules in this tournament. We are playing cross-ice and there will be no red or blue lines on the ice surface.
- Returning Ball to Play: If the ball should leave the playing area, the team that last made contact with the ball must give the opposing team 6 feet from where the ball went out of play to return it to play.
- Goaltending: No special equipment is required. Goalies may not throw the ball.
- Checking: This is a no body contact tournament.
- High Broom: You cannot raise your broom higher than shoulder height. If you make contact with the ball higher than shoulder height it results in an immediate change of possession. You must hand the ball over to the opposing team and give them a minimal of 6 feet distance to return the ball back to play.
- Penalties: This is a self-refereed recreation experience and the expectation is that there will be no intentional penalties. We understand that mistakes happen and if you unintentionally commit a penalty the result will be loss of possession for your team; please turn the ball over to the other team and give them 6 feet from the spot of the infraction to return the ball to play. If a game is deemed to be getting out of control, an event volunteer will be assigned and any penalties called will result in a goal for the opposing team. Penalties include but are not limited to, tripping, slashing, high sticking, cross checking, roughing, body contact, and unsportsmanlike conduct. Any player involved in a fight will be removed from the game and can be disqualified from the tournament.
- Tie Games: Should the teams be tied at the end of regulation time, the match will be decided by sudden death overtime. The sudden death period will be 1, 5-minute period. If there are no goals scored the game will end in a tie.

****Please remember when playing in this tournament that it was created to be fun for everyone. We are playing on "gentlemen's rules" with no officials. We ask that you play with good sportsmanship on honor.***
