

# The Powelton Club Dress Code

### A. Clubhouse and Grounds

- a. Unacceptable Attire Includes:
- i. Athletic or jogging shorts, other than tennis shorts and Bermuda shorts (knee length).
  - ii. Tank tops, undershirts, or bare tops.
  - iii. Denim jeans or shorts (including designer jeans).
- iv. Men's shirts without collars (juniors under 12 years old excluded from wearing collared shirts).
- b. Mock Turtle Neck shirts are now considered proper attire. A mock turtle neck is a shirt without a traditional collar, but differs from a tee shirt in the following ways: the band around the neck is snug fitting and is at least  $1 \frac{1}{4}$  "wide. Made of a material that is consistent with a traditional golf shirt.
- c. Bathing Suits & Bare Feet are permitted only in the pool and locker areas.
- d. Men must remove hats and visors while in the dining area and 19th Hole.
- e. Shoes must be worn in all dining areas as well.
- f. Men are not required to wear jackets in the upstairs dining room except for special occasions or otherwise notified.

### B. Golf Course

- a. Bathing Suits are not to be worn on the golf course.
- b. Males 12 years old and older must wear collared shirts tucked in at all times on the course.
- c. Barefoot or shoeless play is not permitted by anyone.
- d. Proper dress is required on the golf course by all members and guests, including children.

## C. Tennis Courts

- a. White flat soled tennis shoes must be worn on courts.
- b. Waffled or grooved tennis shoes will not be allowed.
- c. White tennis clothing must be worn at all times, with the exception of warm-up attire.

#### D. Pool

- a. Bathing attire may be worn only at the pool.
- b. No metal hair accessories should be worn in the pool or pool area.
